



Terms&Conditions Annual Youth Card 2020-2021

Youth card is available for kids between 7 and 21 years, runs from September 1st through August 31st.

The Youth Plan (ages 7-21)

Wassenaarse Golfclub Rozenstein has officially been awarded the certification "Committed to Youth" by the Netherlands Golf Federation (NGF). This means that the club has demonstrated to offer a structured Youth Plan in line with the NGF requirements set to take Dutch youth golf to a higher level for both the recreational and competitive golfer. Under the motto "Train, Play and Fun" the Rozenstein Youth Committee enthuses, trains and prepares the youth for the compulsory requirements/certificates as set by the NGF for all golfers in the Netherlands. The initial stage is to obtain Course Permission (HCP 55), followed by the Golf Skills Certificate (HCP 54) and of course the ultimate goal - to lower your official EGA Handicap. Youth between the age of 7 and 21 are eligible to sign up for Rozenstein's Annual Youth Card.

The Youth Committee looks after the interests of the youth within Rozenstein and keeps them informed of all relevant activities both in- and outside the club. The youth teams receive approximately 45 hours of training sessions per year. These sessions are provided by the Rozenstein golf professionals. Each team normally consists of 7 youths grouped not only by age but where possible also on golf experience and ability. The training sessions are held mainly on Sunday and are mainly planned outside of Dutch school holidays.

Our Youth Team leaders support the Pro during the training. After the training they take their team for further practise to the Par 3 course or to the golf course, depending on the team's playing level. The training always ends in the club house with refreshments and team discussions on the day's progress. The Team leaders not only accompany the teams during the training but where necessary also during club competitions and other golf related activities.

The Annual Youth Card costs € 470 per annum (September thru August) and includes:

- Approx. 45 hours team training sessions led by golf Professional and Team leader - driving range balls provided free of charge
- Daily allowance of 160 driving range balls free of charge - not accumulative
- Participation in Club youth competitions
- Participation in NGF youth competition (EGA HCP 36 or better) upon selection
- Use of all practise facilities and Par 3 course
- Use of main course after obtaining HCP 54
- Use of main course after obtaining HCP 55 and accompanied by a Team leader or adult with HCP 54 (or less) or a youth member with HCP 36 (or less).

Conditions for participation in and extension of the annual youth card are:

1. Positive attitude towards the weekly training
2. Presence of at least 75% of youth training sessions
3. Active participation in the golf competitions and activities
4. For kids with EGA handicap of 54 and below, to play at least 4 qualifying cards per year, of which at least 2 during competition organized by Rozenstein Golfclub
5. Adherence to golf rules, etiquette and rules of the game.

The youth committee reserves the right, at their discretion, to cancel or revoke the Youth card at any given moment in the event that the child does not or does not sufficiently adhere to the rules as laid out above. Before this decision is being made, there will be a talk with parents and child involved. In the event that the youth card is revoked, there will be no restitution of the annual fee. Cancellation of the annual youth card should be done by July 1, by email. In the event that the cancellation has not been received in a timely manner, the club reserves the right to charge the annual fee. Upon cancellation of the annual youth card, the materials

provided (E-range key and bag tag e.g.) should be returned to the office. The Youth Committee reserves the right to suggest youth to the Board to become club members.
