To all members,

Due to the rising corona infections, the government has adopted stricter measures as of November 6 to try to bring the infection rate down. It is advised to keep one and a half meters of distance, to wear mouth masks in public places, to avoid shaking hands, to wash your hands a lot, to cough and sneeze at the elbow and to stay at home and get tested in case of a cold or flu symptoms.

The Rozenstein administration will apply the stricter measures to Rozenstein as well. This means that we will check QR codes of people over the age of 18, who come to the clubhouse and/or to the restaurant. Staff are exempt from this by law. If you do not have a code you will not be allowed into the clubhouse and restaurant starting November 6! The locker rooms and toilets are also included in this.

Playing without a QR code is allowed, but please leave the booking to your flight companion.

The locker rooms are closed from the clubhouse, because otherwise no complete access control is possible. It is therefore wise to wear a mouth mask just like at flow-through locations.

A consequence of the measure is that we advise people without QR code to get their golf gear out of the locker before Saturday and take it home. Or else have this done by another member in possession of a valid QR code.

The next three weeks the checking of the QR code will be done by hired staff, not members of the club. The first few days possibly by board members. They will be in the lobby of the clubhouse.

We can imagine lots of different types of comments. The only thing that applies to the board is, "So be it"

Let's hope that by applying the rules, corona will soon come under control.
