



## General Terms and Conditions Annual Youth Card in Youth Plan

The Annual Youth Card (Jeugdjaarkaart) is for children  
from 7 to 21 years of age



The Annual Youth card runs from September 1st to August 31st

### **The Youth Plan (ages 7-21)**

Wassenaaarse Golfclub Rozenstein has officially been awarded the certification “Committed to Youth” by the Dutch Golf Federation (NGF). This means that the club has demonstrated to offer a structured Youth Plan in line with the NGF requirements set to take Dutch youth golf to a higher level for both the recreational and competitive golfer. Under the motto “Train, Play and Fun” the Rozenstein Youth Committee enthuses, trains and prepares the youth for the compulsory requirements/certificates as set by the NGF for all golfers in the Netherlands. The initial stage is to obtain Course Permission (HCP 55), followed by the Golf Skills Certificate (HCP 54) and of course the ultimate goal - to lower your official handicap. Youth between the age of 7 and 21 are eligible to sign up for Rozenstein’s Annual Youth Card.

### **Teams and training**

The Youth Committee looks after the interests of the youth within Rozenstein and keeps them informed of all relevant activities both in- and outside the club. The youth teams receive approximately 45 hours of training sessions per year. These sessions are provided by the Rozenstein golf professionals. Each team normally consists of 7 youths grouped not only by age but where possible also on golf experience and ability. The training sessions are held on Sunday mornings and are mainly planned outside of Dutch school holidays.

Our Youth Team leaders support the Pro during the training. After the training they take their team for further practise to the Par 3 course or to the golf course, depending on the team’s playing level. The training always ends in the club house with refreshments and team discussions on the day’s progress. The Team leaders not only accompany the teams during the training but where necessary also during club competitions and other golf related activities.

The cost associated with the Annual Youth Card is 50% of the fee for a regular adult membership. For annual dues, please visit [www.rozenstein.nl](http://www.rozenstein.nl)

### **Included are:**

- Approximately 30 practices led by pro and team leader, free balls during practices
- Unlimited use of the practice facilities (driving range, putting/chipping green, Par 3 course)
- Unlimited use of the 18 hole course by youth in possession of a WHS handicap of 54 or lower
- Approximately 120 driving range balls (straight decline) daily
- Youth in possession of a WHS handicap of 55 (course permission) can use the course under supervision of a team leader, an adult in possession of a WHS handicap of 54 or lower or a youth member with a WHS handicap lower than 36

A WHS handicap of 54 must be obtained at Rozenstein. If obtained elsewhere, it will be determined in consultation with the pros whether there is sufficient golf proficiency on the part of the Youth Member.

The Youth Committee will select on the basis of age and optimal team composition.

### **Conditions**

The conditions for participation in the plan and renewal of the annual card are:

1. Positive attitude and commitment.
2. Attendance at at least 75% of group training sessions.
3. Active participation in youth games and youth activities.
4. For children in possession of a WHS handicap of 54 and below: playing at least 4 qualifying cards, at least 2 of which must be played in club-organized competitions.
5. Compliance with golf rules, etiquette and game rules.
6. Red membership tag always clearly visible on bag.
7. The Rozenstein Youth Code of Conduct applies to all Annual Cardholders.
8. A Annual Youth Cardholder may not introduce and has no voting rights.

The youth committee reserves the right, at their discretion, to cancel or revoke the Youth card at any given moment in the event that the child does not or does not sufficiently adhere to the rules as laid out above. Before this decision is being made, there will be a talk with parents and child involved. In the event that the youth card is revoked, there will be no restitution of the annual fee.

### **Youth membership**

When a handicap 36 or lower has been achieved, an Annual Youth Cardholder can be invited to the youth league line. The Annual Youth Card is then converted to Youth Membership in the Youth Plan. Upon reaching age 21, the Youth Plan ends, but one can remain a Youth Member until age 27.

The Youth Committee nominates potential Year Card holders/children who wish to become Youth Members to the Board. Potential Youth Members are "pre-screened" to the membership and follow the same procedure as potential Regular Members in this regard.

### **21 years**

Annual Cardholders who have reached the age of 21 and are not yet Youth Members may transfer to the Green NGF Subscription or apply for Youth Membership themselves.

### **Contribution and cancellation**

The subscription year runs from September 1 to August 31, Annual Youth Cards are automatically renewed after one year until cancellation. Cancellation for the next Annual Youth Card season must be notified by email no later than August 1<sup>st</sup>. ([secretariaat@rozenstein.nl](mailto:secretariaat@rozenstein.nl)). After the first year you can cancel per month, with a notice period of 1 month. When mid-year entry is made, that is the effective date for the first year. When the year card is cancelled the material provided by the club -such as the e-range key and the red disk- must be returned to the secretariat. If these are not returned, costs will be charged.

### **Entrance during the year**

Entry during the year is possible in consultation with the Youth Committee, the secretariat and the pros. Invoicing will be pro-rata for the variable costs.
